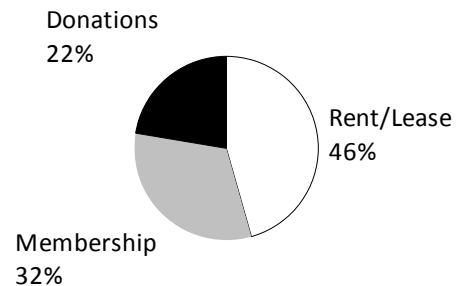

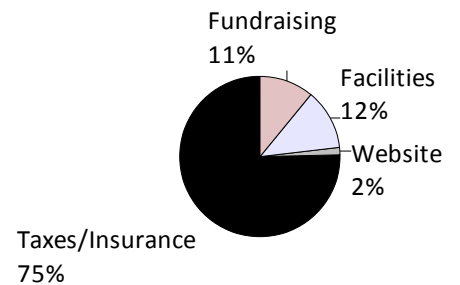
Join us for a Pot Luck Lunch on Sat, February 19<sup>th</sup>, 12 Noon – 4pm.
